RULES & REGULATIONS OF THE MAINE JAZZ CAMP

- 1. DRUGS, ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO: Use or possession will result in automatic and immediate dismissal with no refund and no return to Maine Jazz Camp.
- 2. INCENSE BURNING is prohibited at all times
- 3. PRANKS AND BULLYING: Verbal and physical bullying or pranks will not be tolerated.
- 4. DESTRUCTION OF PERSONAL & SCHOOL PROPERTY will result in immediate dismissal with no refund. Loss of personal property, property damage, induced accident or injury or the cost of malicious acts of vandalism are the personal responsibility of the perpetrator and their adult guardian or parents. Further investigation may include police investigation for #1, 2 and 3. The elevators should be used with care and smoke detectors and fire extinguishers should not be touched at all. No climbing of trees or telephone poles on campus.
- 5. INSTRUMENT INSURANCE: The insurance of the camper's instrument against theft and damage is the responsibility of the camper. Maine Jazz Camp cannot take any responsibility in case of theft, damage or loss of personal items.
- 6. VISITATION: Boys will stay on floors assigned to boys only and the same applies to the girls. Visitation in dorm rooms between sexes is not permitted.

All visitors must check in at the MJC office in Mallett Hall upon entering. Visitors are subject to the rules and regulations of Maine Jazz Camp.

No student is permitted to go beyond the areas confined to camp once the camp is in session. Walks into town are definitely prohibited.

- 7. MOTOR VEHICLES: Students are not allowed to bring a car or any vehicle to Maine Jazz Camp. However, if a student does have a license a written consent from the parents should be sent in along with the application. In this case, the car should remain parked during the camp session. Driving someone else's car or vehicle is not permitted.
- 8. INSURANCE: Maine Jazz Camp cannot be held liable or responsible in any way for personal injury or negligent behavior on the part of any student. Please be careful.
- 9. PRACTICING: No practicing in dorm rooms. There are specified places & times.
- 10. PUNCTUALITY: Be on time for all classes and concerts. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each class.
- 11. LIGHTS OUT: Students are required to be on their dorm floors by 10:00 p.m. each night. Lights are out at 10:30 p.m. Any student not accounted for at these times will be searched by staff and campus police. Flagrant violation of this rule may result in dismissal with no refund.
